


Graphic 1: Candidates vs. Vacancies, 2018-2023






Graphic 2: Evolution of Numbers of Enrolled Students, 2018-2023


Graphic 3: Students Enrolled by Faculty/School






Graphic 4: Evolution of Enrolled Students and New Admissions, 2018-2023

Graphic 5: Students Enrolled by Academic Degrees and Gender




Graphic 6: Graduated Students by Faculty/School



Graphic 7: Scholarship holders by Types of and Fees




Graphic 8: Teaching-staff by Contractual Relationship





Graphic 9: Teachers by Nationality


